PROGRAM

This six-week study abroad program aims to guide students towards a deep understanding of global urban dynamics in a uniquely vibrant, exciting, complex and historical metropolis of the Global South: Istanbul. Students will experience the ways in which Istanbul succeeds in being a cosmopolitan bridge between the East and West (a metropolis of rare sociality, a sophisticated site of art and culture, and an urban identity of politesse and civility), as well as the ways it fails to achieve other global metropolitan standards (its urban poor and marginalized populations, scarred earth and polluted air, and inhabitants burdened by various problems). Through immersive experiences and critical exploration, students will create life-long memories in one of the most captivating cities at the crossroads of global urban life.

LOCATION

Istanbul is the only city in the world that straddles two continents, Asia and Europe! It is consistently ranked as one of the most visited cities in the world, topping even the likes of Rome, Paris, or London. With it's vibrant culture, rich history, and stunning architecture, it's no wonder why people flock there.

EXCURSIONS

Program excursions will include visits to Sultanahmet, Istanbul's historical old town and a UNESCO World Heritage Site with immersive experiences in Hagia Sophia and the Blue Mosque; unique museums like the Museum of Innocence and the Pera Museum; neighborhoods with distinct urban characters; a cruise along the Bosphorus Strait; and a day-trip to the Prince's Islands.

HOUSING

Students will stay in double-occupancy rooms in a local college dormitory in the Besiktas neighborhood, in the center of Istanbul. Rooms will be shared with other students on the program.

2025 PRICING

Undergraduate Program Fee: \$6,535

A \$395 nonrefundable deposit toward the total cost of the program is due at the time of application. The remaining fees are due no later than 45 days prior to departure. If you receive financial aid, you can defer payment until it disburses. Deferment decisions will be based on the amount of aid to be received.
